Played in December at **Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium** in **Annapolis, Md**., the Military Bowl is broadcast nationally on ESPN.

FOUNDED IN 2008

The mission of the Military Bowl is to benefit our nation's service members including a partnership with **USO** and the operation of **Patriot Point**, our 294-acre retreat for recovering service members, their families and caregivers on Maryland's Eastern Shore.

Since its inception in 2008, the Military Bowl has provided over 25,000 complimentary tickets to active duty and veteran service members; generated more than \$1M in donations to USO; and raised \$3M to establish Patriot Point, that annually hosts more than 400 guests for over 1,500 annual days of use.



Community Outreach


